To the Board of directors of KLJ RESOURCES LIMITED

Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

1. Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial results of KLJ Resources Limited (the company) for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2023 ("standalone financial results"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended ("Listing Regulations").

2. Basis for Opinion

In preparing the consolidated financial results, the respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its associate entity are responsible for assessing the ability of the Group and its associate to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Group or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The respective Board of Directors of the Companies included in the Group and its associate are responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the Group and its associate.

4. Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the consolidated financial results as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these consolidated financial results.

- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the financial results/financial information of the entities within the Group and its associate to express an opinion on the consolidated Financial Results. We are responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audit of financial information of such entities included in the consolidated financial results of which we are the independent auditors. For the other entities included in the consolidated Financial Results, which have been audited by other auditors, such other auditors remain responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audits carried out by them. We remain solely responsible for our audit opinion.

We communicate with those charged with governance of the Holding Company and such other entities included in the consolidated financial results of which we are the independent auditors regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, as amended, to the extent applicable.

5. Other Matters

We did not audit the financial statements/Consolidated financial statements/financial information of Four Indian subsidiaries and one foreign subsidiary (including its subsidiary and associate), whose interim financial statements/ financial information/ financial results reflect total revenue of Rs 11,755.06 lakhs and Rs 58,247.16 lakhs, total net profit after tax of (205.99) lakhs and Rs 363.76 lakhs, total comprehensive profit of Rs 238.05 lakhs and Rs 807.80 lakhs, total assets Rs. 20,780.70 lakhs for the quarter ended and year ended 31.03.2023 respectively and as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. The consolidated Ind As financial statements also include the Group's share of net profit/(Loss) of Rs. (66.72) lakhs for the year ended 31st March, 2023, as considered in the consolidated Ind As financial statements in respect of 1 associate whose financial statements / financial information have not been audited by us. These financial statements/financial information of have been audited by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated Ind AS financial statements, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and associate, and our report in terms of sub-section (3) and (11) of section 143 of the Act, in so far as it relates to the aforesaid subsidiaries and associate, is based solely on the reports of such other auditors.

Our opinion on the consolidated Financial Results is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditors.

- i. The Financial Results include the results for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 being the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year which were subject to limited review by us.
- ii. The consolidated annual financial results dealt with by this report have been prepared for the express purpose of filing with the Stock Exchanges. These results are based on and should be read with the audited consolidated financial statements of the group and its associate, for the year ended March 31, 2023 on which we have issued an unmodified audit opinion vide our report dated May 30, 2023.
